### 2 Connection to AiM devices

Peugeot Funyo SP05 2015 is equipped with a Peugeot 1.6 Ir turbo engine. The vehicle ECU features a bus communication protocol based on CAN that can be reached on a plastic box placed behind the steering wheel and shown here below. As you can see there are four free wires coming from the plastic box, to be used for CAN connection. Bottom of the image is connection table.



Wire colour	Pin function	AiM cable
Red	CAN High	CAN+
Grey	CAN Low	CAN-

**Please note**: if your AiM device is SoloDL, EVO4 or ECU Bridge CAN/RS232 version with free wires (**X90BGGPI2RMA**) it is necessary to remove the 120 Ohm resistor you find between CAN High and CAN Low in the device cable

- ECU manufacturer: "Peugeot"
- ECU Model: "Funyo\_sp05"
